1. MADE FOR THIS [I PETER 2:5]

The core problem is not that we are too passionate about bad things, but that we are not passionate enough about good things. - Larry Crabb

2. LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS [I PETER 2:9]

God's call is twofold and is confirmed in two ways. There is a general calling He offers to everyone; <u>anyone who responds</u> to Him is considered the "called" (Is. 6:8). But a second call is more specific. This specific call is given to individuals who are meant to <u>serve in a particular role</u> (Acts 9:3–6). This calling is confirmed both by an inward witness of the heart and an outward recognition by the body of Christ. - John Maxwell

3. THE CHOICE [I PETER 4:10]

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths. - Solomon

Their trust should be in God, who richly gives us all we need for our enjoyment. ¹⁸ Tell them to use their money to do good. They should be rich in good works and generous to those in need, always being ready to share with others. ¹⁹ By doing this they will be storing up their treasure as a good foundation for the future so that they may experience true life. [apolausin = full] enjoyment]
