Psalm 119:17-24

- ¹⁷ Deal bountifully with your servant, [intimacy] [Philippians 4:19] that I may live and keep your word.
- ¹⁸ Open my eyes, [uncover] that I may behold [pay attention to] wondrous things out of your law. [amazing things of God]
- ¹⁹ I am a sojourner on the earth; [temporary resident] hide not your commandments from me! [Proverbs 6:22]
- ²⁰ My soul is consumed [H: crushed in pieces]

with longing for your rules at all times. [desire → habit]
 ²¹ You rebuke the insolent, accursed ones,

who wander from your commandments. [Psalm 119:10]

²² Take away from me scorn and contempt, [covering to be removed] for I have kept your testimonies. [Psalm 1:1-3]
²³ Even though princes sit plotting against me, [I Peter 4:19]

your servant will meditate on your statutes. [Proverbs 6:23] ²⁴ Your testimonies are my delight; they are my counselors.

Study Questions/Prayer

[1] Read Psalm 119:17-20. Where do you find comfort when life becomes difficult and stressful? What three responses mentioned in the outline do you lean on to get through these seasons?

[2] Read Psalm 119:21-24. These verses promise that when we are overwhelmed God has our back, and we have a personal responsibility to stay focused on the word of God. What can we learn and apply from these verses in our lives?
[3] Pray for God to help you see His will clearly every day as you focus on His word and calling on your life.
