Act 1: Rupture of a nation - irresponsible leadership (Ch. 10)

rupture - the act of breaking

Your inner circle matters - What to look for:

- 2) Heart for God: People who place God first and live out His values**
- 3) Objectivity: People who see the pros and cons of the issues**
- 4) Love for People: People who love others and value them more than things**
- 5) Complimentary Gifts: People who bring diverse gifts to a relationship**
- 6) Loyalty to the Leader: People who are truly concerned about you**

remarkable - worthy of attention

Act 3: Retrogress of a culture - inconsistent leadership (Ch. 12)

retrogress: to go backward into an earlier and usually worse condition
