#### PSALM 42

#### I. Passionate desire for God's Presence and Community (1-5)

- A. Longing for the Presence of God (1-2)
- B. The Journey Oppression and Memories that Keep Him Going (3-4)
- C. The Choice of Hope (5)

## II. The Oppression that Keeps Him from God's Presence and Community (6-11)

- A. He continues to lament all the oppressive things that are happening to himprompting him to pray (6-7)
- B. The writer's response He finds confidence in the Lord and his comfort both day and night (8-10)
- C. The Choice of Hope (11)

This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah:18 "Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul is well pleased. I will put my Spirit upon him, and he will proclaim justice to the Gentiles.

<sup>19</sup> He will not quarrel or cry aloud, nor will anyone hear his voice in the streets; <sup>20</sup> a bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not quench, until he brings justice to victory; <sup>21</sup> and in his name the Gentiles will hope."
