Discussion Questions:

- 1. How often do you pray for your friends?
- 2. Paul talks about the great team at Philippi in verse 5 that was special to him since day 1 of their ministry together (v. 7a). Their team was unified behind the gospel in the good times and challenging times of their ministry together (v. 7b). Have you been on any great teams? If so, what were the characteristics that made the team so special?
- 3. In Philippians 1:8-11 Paul points to 4 characteristics of a great team member. Why do you think he started his list with love for each other? (Read John 13:35)
- 4. Commit to encouraging three people today by texting them, emailing them, or calling them. Make your goal to encourage them and help them see themselves like Jesus sees them.

- ⁹ And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, ¹⁰ so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
