Discussion Questions:

- 1. Finding purpose in life is a process for all of us. What clue does John give us in I John 2:28 about our primary purpose in life? As you think about this focus on the word abide.
- 2. Read Ephesians 3:20-21. Do you feel God at work in your life right now? In what ways? Discuss.
- 3. Are you content in your life right now? Do you need to refocus in some areas? Read Matthew 11:28-30 and pray for God to focus you on abiding in Him this week.
