# **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read Psalm 1:2. When do you spend time (abide) in God's word during the day? Discuss.
- Read II Timothy 3:16. How do we know the Bible is true? Discuss. For more insight go to GotQuestions.org
- Read about how fruit-bearing impacts our lives (Point III). Evaluate where you are in these areas as you abide in Christ. Pray together focusing on the strength to be fruit-bearers for the kingdom.

John 15:1-11: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser.<sup>2</sup> Every branch in me that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. <sup>3</sup> Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup> Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. <sup>5</sup> I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup> If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. <sup>7</sup> If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. <sup>8</sup> By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.<sup>9</sup> As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in His love. <sup>11</sup> These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

#### Abiding Wisdom from I John 2:

... whoever says he abides in Him ought to walk in the same way in which He walked. **(2:6)** 

Whoever loves his brother abides in the light, and in Him there is no cause for stumbling. **(2:10)** 

And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever. (2:17)

Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, then you too will abide in the Son and in the Father. 25 And this is the promise that He made to us-eternal life. **(2:24-25)** 

I write these things to you about those who are trying to deceive you. <sup>27</sup> But the anointing that you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need that anyone should teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie—just as it has taught you, abides in him. **(2:26-27)** 

And now, little children, abide in him, so that when He appears we may have confidence and not shrink from Him in shame at his coming. **(2:28)**
