

BUILDING A STRONG FOUNDATION PHILIPPIANS 1:6

1. Foundation of Love (John 15:9)

Jesus chose to love, and I can't earn it

- 2. Foundation of Forgiveness (Rom. 5:8) Jesus loves me regardless of my sin
- 3. Foundation of Worth (John 15:13)

Jesus chose to die for me

- 4. Foundation of Promise (Matt. 28:20b) Jesus will always love me
- 5. Foundation of Life (2 Timothy 3:14)

Jesus' love is the foundation for the rest of my life

Philippians 1:6: I am sure of this, that he who started a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

John 15:9: As the Father has loved me, I have also loved you. Remain in my love.

Romans 5:8: But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

John 15:13: No one has greater love than this: to lay down his life for his friends

Matthew 28:20b: And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

2 Timothy 3:14: But as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed. You know

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read Matthew 9:9-13. Jesus was having a meal with quite a crew! Having a meal with someone says a lot, and these moments speak volumes about the love of Jesus that is extended to all people. Read John 3:17 for more insight about God's love for us. What can we learn from Jesus in these moments? Discuss.
- Read John 15:13. Jesus loves you so much that he died on a cross for you. This shows your incredible worth to Him! How can we sacrifice for those around us and show them the love of Jesus with our lives? Discuss.
